Notes for Artisans/Handicrafters

- The Handicraft Fair will be located at Emmanuel Baptist Church in Fallbrook.
- The Fair will be outside on grass, rain or shine. **Bring your own** shade or rain protection depending on weather.
- The Fair takes place December 2nd, from 9:30am to 1pm-ish.
- You should arrive to start setting up at 9:00 am sharp
- Each family will be responsible for creating a display their crafts; **you must bring your own tables, stands, easels,** etc. as desired.
- If you need power, you MUST contact Brooke ASAP @ allgoodthingsleadership@gmail.com
- Typically, items are priced between \$1-\$5, with the occasional item being more than that as necessary.
- Remember to bring smaller dollar bills for giving change and buying items from other families.
- We welcome and encourage artisans who will sell **lunch**, **snack or**, **drink items**. These items are always a blessing to the families that will be there all day.
- You are welcome to **invite friends and family** to the fair as well.
- There are restrooms with multiple stalls and sinks for handwashing that will be available for us to use.
- Remember to **bring a small "thanksgiving donation"** for our host, *Emmanuel Baptist.* It is SUCH a blessing to be welcomed and encouraged to use their facilities for our gathering.
- Artisans will be allowed to "shop" for 15 minutes at 9:15am before the customers arrive will at 9:30. (3)

We Recommend: you share a booth with other family members and members take turns manning the booth. We also recommend that you do NOT set out all your goods at the beginning. Save some for the end.
